

Dance Company Placement

Placement in the Jazzle/Jazzle elite dance companies are based on the following criteria:

- Technique
- Dance ability
- Potential
- Commitment level
- Enthusiasm
- Behavior
- Performance presence
- Age as of January 1st of competition season

Auditions are required to join our dance companies. After auditions dancers will be placed in either:

Registration Process

- You will receive an email with your audition results on <u>May 12th 2025</u>
- 2. If your dancer is selected to a company member, you must respond to the email with your acceptance by May 25th 2025
- 3. After we receive your acceptance, we will set up your parent portal account as a *company dancer account*. We will register your dancer for their required classes and your tuition price will be set
- 4. You will receive an email confirmation with class and group rehearsal schedule
- 5. If you would like to register your dancer for additional classes, you may do so by emailing us at contact@jazzledancestudio.com after you receive your confirmation email

Dress Code

Dance Company members must wear only the following dancewear to every dance class & rehearsal

Girls: Class Level Leotard

Boys: White Shirt

Black form fitting shorts or leggings

Black form fitting warm-up top/sweater

Dance shoes

Hair must be securely pulled back

There will be no exceptions given for class unpreparedness

If a dancer is not prepared for class/rehearsal they will not be allowed to participate in class, which will count as an absence

Dance company uniforms will be distributed at the beginning of each season. Dancers should wear their class level leotard until they receive company uniform

Time Commitment

Dance Company is a team sport that requires attendance at all classes & rehearsals. Absences will hold back not only the individual dancer, the company as a whole

Extra rehearsals may be scheduled:

- 1. During studio breaks
- 2. During competition season: Fridays, Saturdays and/or Sundays

Parents will be notified of extra rehearsals at least one week prior to rehearsal

Each dancer is allowed <u>5 excused absences</u> from <u>ALL classes and</u> <u>rehearsals</u> after which, they will be dismissed from the team

COMPANY MEMBERS MUST ATTEND ALL CLASSES 1 week prior to any convention, competition or other performance

Regional conventions and competitions are a FRIDAY-SUNDAY (FULL WEEKEND) COMMITMENT

National competitions are a SUNDAY-SATURDAY (FULL WEEK) COMMITMENT

Jazzle Dance Studio <u>will not receive</u> convention or competition schedules until <u>5-7 days prior</u> to the competition

IT IS POSSIBLE that regional competitions will begin on <u>Friday morning</u> by which dancers may be required to miss school.

Parent Commitment

Props

Props are often used to elevate a routine. If a choreographer requires usage of a prop for a dance, parents are responsible for finding the prop that is needed, costs that are associated with building or purchasing the prop (included in dues) and transportation of props to and from every competition.

Prop Dads

Prop dads are needed to build, transport, load & unload and place props on/off stage. Prop dads are required to be at dress rehearsal and all performances & competitions.





Routine Assignments

1 hip hop small routines: REQUIRED

Routines will be assigned in July before choreography camp

3 Small/large group routines: REQUIRED

Routines will be assigned in July before choreography camp

Duets/Trios: Specially assigned by teachers.

If dancer is selected to do a duet/trio, \$50/month will be added to tuition.

Solos

Parent/Dancer can register for a maximum of 2 solos: OPTIONAL



Parents/dancers reserve the right to disapprove any routine or costume choice. In such a case a parent is allowed to withdraw their dancer from the routine. Once assigned, all routine and costumes are final No refunds or credits will be given for tuition or dues.

Teachers Assistant Program

Our Teacher Assistant Program is for Jazzlette & Jazzler dancers interested in assisting our Jazzle Baby and Jazzle Tot dance classes. Assistants will help with the flow of the dance class, help set up props, help guide students during class, give fun reinforcements for correct dance steps and serve as a role model for the Jazzle babies and tots. Assistants will also be expected to provide any other additional assistance that helps with the dance class.

Requirements

Each dance season teachers will select a limited number of dancers who exhibit the qualities necessary to be a successful teaching assistant:

- •Dancers must apply for the Teacher Assistant position
- •Teacher Assistants must complete a mandatory Assistant training session each season
- •Assistants must be registered for Jazzle Elite Dance Company
- Assistants must have the maturity and disposition to deal with children in a busy dance class
- •Assistants must be good role models. They must use their voice when appropriate in the classroom
- •Assistants must have been a Jazzle student for 1 recital season prior
- •Assistants must attend all their dance classes and rehearsals weekly
- •Assistants must participate in all Jazzle Dance Studio performances, recitals and competitions
- •Assistants must maintain a B (or comparable) grade point average
- •Assistants must be committed to our program from August thru June

Dance studios from all over the country travel to a regional location to attend competition nationals. They compete for national prizes and recognition.




Dance Competitions

There are many competition systems. Studio owners select which competitions they register for which is dependent on location, availability and difficulty.

Competition systems host **REGIONALS** in every state from <u>January to May</u>

Competition systems host **NATIONALS** in one or more geographical region in <u>June and July</u>















Dance Conventions

Competition systems host dance **CONVENTIONS** in **October -February**

Competition dancers from different dance studio spend 1-3 days on the weekend taking a full day/s of dance classes. They take classes in different styles of dance from world renowned dance teachers.



Conventions have auditions for scholarships and competition touring opportunities. Teachers also recognize students in different class based on their enthusiasm, technique and stand out quality.







Competition Dance Routine Types

- Gymnastics/Acro Routine that may contain gymnastic passes, walkovers, limbers, headstands, chest rolls, etc. Definite choreography should be used to blend gymnastics and dance together.
- Ballet Routine that must include classical steps and ballet technique. Ballet slippers only.
- Baton Routine using baton(s) and baton technique.
- **Character -** Routine portraying an easily recognizable character throughout, such as a cat, clown, etc. with music, costume and dance. Can incorporate any form of dance or gymnastics/acrobatics.
- **Cheerleading-**Routine must use cheerleading style technique. Each routine must blend combination of leaps, jumps, vocal cheering and a display of precision throughout with strong sharp movements.
- Clogging Routine using clogging technique.
- Contemporary A routine that combines both lyrical and modern movements.
- Drill Team Precision marching in military and/or dance style. Can use hand props. (NO SOLOS).
- Fashion Modeling Formal (solos only) Any party dress or "After 5" attire. Runway "T-style" modeling, which must include modeling technique.
- Folkloric Routine incorporating ethnic styles of dance such as polkas, Hawaiian, Spanish, etc.
- Hip Hop A dance which consists of the latest street dance style, as seen in current dance videos.
- Jazz Routine using jazz technique with such moves as kicks, splits, isolations, etc.
- Lyrical Routine encompassing the use of balance, flexibility and control utilizing the lyrics or mood of the music.
- Modern Interpretive Dance using balance and control. Must be contemporary modern style.
- Musical Theater A routine featuring any style of dance interpreting a song from a "Broadway" or movie musical. ("SINGING IS PERMITTED")
- Open This category is for any routine that falls into any of our performance categories, or any combination thereof, or any style of dance.
- Pantomime/Lip Sync A portrayal of a stereotype or impersonation through pantomime and costume; mimicking the voice on a tape.
- Pointe Routine must include classical steps and ballet pointe technique. Pointe shoes only.
- Pompon Routine that must include such elements as marching, clean, sharp arm movements, kicks, leaps, jumps and splits.
- Song and Dance Routine that must contain both singing and any category of dance (tap, jazz, ballet, etc.) Accompaniment must be pre recorded and backup voices only will be permitted.
- Tap Routine comprised of tap technique.
- Vocal Routine may be any type of vocal presentation. Accompaniment must be pre recorded. No lead vocals permitted on recording. Back up voices only will be permitted (Advanced Division only)





